Frequently Asked Questions

Will the day be more like a glorified daycare?

Absolutely not, we will continue to use our current curriculum and will continue to educate based on individual abilities. We always have some 3K students who would be better served in 4K and vice versa based on where they are at developmentally.

Will there be big changes to who is here and on which days?

Most people will likely maintain their current schedules with a few opting to send their child(ren) an additional day or two.

Will there be too many children in class?

We will keep our enrollment at current recommended classroom capacity of less than 20 students.

Why are you doing this?

We know what we have here is special. We want to remain relevant to the needs of the families by offering more options while maintaining a fun, challenging learning environment.

Do you think my child will get what he or she needs being in 4K with younger students?

Absolutely! Most will be approximately the same age. Older students will have an opportunity for leadership roles and sharing their knowledge/skills.

How will the 4K get the group instruction they need when 3K students begin to get impatient and wiggly?

All students will participate in instruction and group discussions. As needed younger students will move to related active engagement activities with the classroom aide. Our primary teacher, Mrs. Drews, will continue instruction with the older students and/or students who are developmentally ready.
